SUGGESTIBILITY TEST #4

This test is a permissive version of the Hand Clasp Test. The development of this method during World War II by psychiatrists who preferred non-directive approaches

SUGGESTIBILITY TEST #5

Postural Sway Test – (Sometimes called Falling Backward Test)

This test is very authoritative and is primarily used by stage hypnotists. It requires touchi clinical setting could cause transference problems.

We do not detail this here as this test needs to be practiced only with extreme caution

SUGGESTIBILITY TEST #6

Progressive Relaxation Test - a permissive test of Relaxation

In addition to acting as an important induction procedure, the progressive relaxation methor gestibility test that works almost universally. Upon completion, check for subjective reaction client; i.e., numbness, tingling, lightness, heaviness, salivation, eyelid flutter, sensory detailed addition, question your client about time distortion. The feedback you receive will be in future sessions.
